Ecclesiastes 2:13

Folly - silliness, silliness in a morally wicked or perverse way.

Proverbs 5:23 *He shall die without instruction; and in the greatness of his folly he shall go astray.*

Proverbs 13:16 *Every prudent man dealeth with knowledge: but a fool layeth open his folly.*

Proverbs 14:8 *The wisdom of the prudent is to understand his way: but the folly of fools is deceit.*

Proverbs 14:24 *The crown of the wise is their riches: but the foolishness of fools is folly.*

Proverbs 15:21 *Folly is joy to him that is destitute of wisdom: but a man of understanding walketh uprightly.*

Proverbs 17:12 *Let a bear robbed of her whelps meet a man, rather than a fool in his folly.*

Proverbs 26:4-5 *Answer not a fool according to his folly, lest thou also be like unto him. [5] Answer a fool according to his folly, lest he be wise in his own conceit.*

Proverbs 26:11 *As a dog returneth to his vomit, so a fool returneth to his folly.*

Ecclesiastes 1:17 *And I gave my heart to know wisdom, and to know madness and folly: I perceived that this also is vexation of spirit.*

Hebrews 12:11-16 *Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby. [12] Wherefore lift up the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees; [13] And make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way; but let it rather be healed. [14] Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord: [15] Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled; [16] Lest there be any fornicator, or profane person, as Esau, who for one morsel of meat sold his birthright.*
